Course description: This course provides attendees with a more broad-based view of the multiple, inter-related skills and techniques used for transforming data into useful "work products." The course utilizes a functional template, called the "Intelligence Cycle," for systematically and uniformly processing data from raw, disparate information into "actionable" end products that provide a more "refined" understanding of the problems faced by police agencies, today. In other words...students learn how to effectively connect the dots!
